



## Distinguished Service Award

The ASPMN Distinguished Service Award, established in 2000 by the ASPMN Council of Past Presidents, is presented to a member of ASPMN in recognition of outstanding leadership, participation, and contributions toward achieving the goals of ASPMN. Self nominations are encouraged.

A selection committee made up of ASPMN Past Presidents reviews all nominations for the Distinguished Service Award and selects a nominee for endorsement by the ASPMN Board of Directors.

Nominations should be mailed to the National Office of ASPMN by May 31, 2010.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Nominees must be active members of ASPMN.
- Nominees should have held office, committee chair positions, or been active on one or more committees.
- Nominees must have demonstrated leadership in and contributed to pain management nursing.
- Nominees must have demonstrated support of the goals and mission of ASPMN.

Nomination applications for the Distinguished Service Award should include the following:

1. Completed Application Form (back of this page)
2. Two letters of recommendations from ASPMN members.

### Award

Distinguished Service Award recipients receive complimentary registration to one ASPMN Annual Meeting.

Distinguished Service Award recipients are recognized in *Pathways* and at the ASPMN Annual Meeting. The 2010 Distinguished Service Award recipient will be recognized at the ASPMN Annual Meeting.
